Attendance Update - Exceptional Term-Time Leave

As parents and carers are aware, the

process governing pupil leave of absence during term-time is linked to the Department for Education's stringent term-time leave requirements. This means that the school is unable to authorise pupil leave of absence requests in all but the most exceptional of circumstances, and that the school is obliged to communicate certain unauthorised pupil absences, including those of 5 days or more, to the Local Authority for Holiday Penalty Notice consideration.
