Parking and Road Safety

Please could the school remind parents and

carers of the importance of parking safely and with consideration to the local community when dropping off or picking up pupils from school. In particular, please can we request that parents and carers do not park on the zig-zags or pavement areas immediately outside the school, and avoid parking illegally on double-yellow lines or blocking residents' driveways when parking their vehicle. Inconsiderate or dangerous parking makes it more difficult for pupils to apply their road safety awareness through no fault of their own, and may indeed create dangerous road safety situations that pupils and families (often with younger children and buggies) are then forced to navigate.

Please therefore make every effort to park with consideration to pupil safety at all times.
